2 CONSIDER THE ASPECTS that will impact you most. SAPOA has considered the following:

- 2.1. Property rates decrease by 5% on average. This is despite the publication of a new GV Roll which can be accessed [here](#) and in terms of which valuations increased, on average, by 19%.
- 2.2. Electricity to increase on average by 9.9%.
- 2.3. Water consumption tariff to increase by 14.4%, whilst the fixed charge remains unchanged.
- 2.4. Sanitation to increase by 3.7%.
- 2.5. Refuse to increase by 3.7%.
